## Topdown sweater with Marine borderd

## Explanation

---

A three-quarter sleeve pullover knitted from neck line. Recommend using a Circular Needle. The sample in the photo uses cotton yarn with lame, but you can freely choose the material as long as it is the same thickness. It is a little oversized and has wide sleeves. I hope you adjust the number of steps of the yoke and the reduction of the sleeves as you like.

... Sorry, I'm not an English speaker, so I may not be able to answer your questions.

## Yarn

---

- A** White Trad Cotton LAME / Yokota(Daruma) #2 (25g / 92m) \* 9 to 10  
**B** Navy Trad Cotton / Yokota(Daruma) #10 (25g / 100m) \* 2

## Tools

---

Main Needle (4.0mm), One size thin Needle (3.0mm), 8 Markers, 1 Marker with different color, Scissor, Tapestry Needle

## Gauge

---

24 stitches, 36 rows / width 10cm, height 10cm

Value after knitting and blocking with the Main Needle

## Sizes

---

**Finished Size: Ladies / Japanese L to XL, US 12 to 14 (M to L)**

Body Length: 54cm, Bust: 100cm, Waist: 93cm\*, Neck: 25cm\*, Arm: 43cm, Sleeve: 25cm, Cuff (Under arm): 29cm\*

\* Not include Rib shrinkage

## Abbreviations

---

<b>pm</b>	.....	Put the Marker
<b>BOR</b>	.....	Beginning of round (Slip the Marker that indicates the row break)
<b>slm</b>	.....	Slip the marker Left Needle to Right Needle
<b>K to m</b>	.....	Knit to the Next Marker
<b>SR</b>	.....	Make a Short-Rows for the next stitch (Japanese or German)
<b>turn</b>	.....	Turn the Project
<b>BRK</b>	.....	Brioche Knit
<b>M1R</b>	.....	Make 1 right
<b>M1L</b>	.....	Make 1 left
<b>SKP</b>	.....	Slip, Knit, Pass stitch over (one stitch decrease)
<b>K2tog</b>	.....	Knit 2 stitches together (one stitch decrease)
<b>P2tog</b>	.....	Purl 2 stitches together (one stitch decrease)
<b>SL1yo</b>	.....	Slip 1 yarn over to knit which in previous row
<b>[**] *number</b>		Repeat the operations in [ ] for the number of times

# Instructions

---

## Neck line

**Start to the center in back.** Cast on 136 stitches, join to work in the round.

Split stitch and put the Maker as follows:

pm (BOR), back body 25st, pm, raglan 2st, pm, right arm 10st, pm, raglan 2st, pm, front body 58st, pm, raglan 2st, pm, left arm 10st, pm, raglan 2st, pm, back body 25st.

**Round 1** Knit all, BOR

make 6 rows by 4 stitches Short-Rows. This creates a **Difference** of 9 rows back and front.

**Difference 1** Knit 23, SR, turn.

**Difference 2** Purl 23, BOR, Purl 23, SR, turn.

**Difference 3** Knit 23, BOR, Knit 17, SR, turn.

**Difference 4** Purl 17, BOR, Purl 17, SR, turn.

**Difference 5** Knit 17, BOR, Knit 11, SR, turn.

**Difference 6** Purl 11, BOR, Purl 11, SR, turn.

**Difference 7** Knit 11, BOR, Knit 5, SR, turn.

**Difference 8** Purl 5, BOR, Purl 5, SR, turn.

**Difference 9** Knit 5, BOR.

**Round 2** [K5, K2tog] \*4, K1, Raglan left back: M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, Raglan left front: M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, Raglan right front: M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, Raglan right back: M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K1, [K2tog, K5] \*4, BOR.

**Round 3** K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, BOR.

## Yoke

Repeat 13 times, operations from round 4 to round 9 (until round 82 is reached).

- Odd rows do not increase.
- Row 4 increases only the raglan line on the sleeve side.
- Row 6 and row 8 increase all Lagran lines.

**Round 4** K to m, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, K to m, BOR.

**Round 5** K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, BOR.

**Round 6** K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, BOR.

**Round 7** K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, BOR.

**Round 82** K to m, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, K to m, BOR.

**Round 83** K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, slm, K2, slm, K to m, BOR.

**Round 84** K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, M1L, slm, K2, slm, M1R, K to m, BOR.

When the yoke is knitted, it becomes 416 stitches.

<b>Back body</b>	.....	106 stitches (+56)
<b>Raglan</b>	.....	2 stitches
<b>Right sleeve</b>	.....	94 stitches (+84)
<b>Raglan</b>	.....	2 stitches
<b>Front body</b>	.....	114 stitches (+56)
<b>Raglan</b>	.....	2 stitches
<b>Left sleeve</b>	.....	94 stitches (+84)
<b>Raglan</b>	.....	2 stitches

## Body

Split stitch as follows:

Body 224 stitches (BOR, back body 54 stitches, front body 116 stitches, back body 54 stitches),

Right sleeve 96 stitches, Left sleeve 96 stitches.

- Remove the marker putted in raglan.

- Left and right sleeves rest the stitches.

**Round 1** K54, Underarm: Backward Loop Cast On 8 stitches, K116, Underarm: Backward Loop Cast On 8 stitches, K54, BOR.

From now on, the underlined steps are knitted with B yarn (do not cut the yarn when changing colors).

Repeat 12 times, operations from round 2 to round 9 (until round 97 is reached).

**Round 2** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 3** SL1yo, Knit all the remaining stitches, BOR.

**Round 4** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 5** SL1yo, Knit all the remaining stitches, BOR.

**Round 6** Knit all, Tangle A and B yarns, BOR.

**Round 7 to Round 9** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 97** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 98** SL1yo, Knit all the remaining stitches, BOR, Cut B yarn.

**Round 99** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 100** SL1yo, Knit all the remaining stitches, BOR.

In Round 101, if you knit while changing to one size thin needle, the first step of the rib will be beautiful.

**Round 101** Knit all, BOR.

## Hem

Change to one size thin needle. Knit the ribs on the hem with Single-rib stitches.

**Round 1** [ K, P, K, P, K, P, K, P, K, P, K, P, K, P2tog ] \*16, BOR.

**Round 2 to Round 10** Single-rib stitches all, BOR.

Bind-off the stitches with a technique to stretch. Cut yarn.

## Sleeves (Left and Right)

Put the resting 96 stitches on the needle. **Start to the underarm.** Put the BOR Marker again.

Omitted for the convenience of the text: To fill the hole in the side gap, pick up 1 stitch from the boundary between cast on and the body in Round 1, and do K2tog in round 2.

**Round 1** Pick up 4 stitches from the cast on in underarm, K96, Pick up 4 stitches from the cast on in underarm, BOR.

From now on, the underlined steps are knitted with B yarn (do not cut the yarn when changing colors).

Repeat 9 times, operations from round 2 to round 9 (until round 73 is reached).

**Round 2** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 3** SL1yo, Knit all the remaining stitches, BOR.

**Round 4** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 5** SL1yo, Knit all the remaining stitches, BOR.

**Round 6** Knit all, Tangle A and B yarns, BOR.

**Round 7, Round 8** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 9** Knit to last 2 stitches, K2tog, BOR.

Next Page >>

**Round 73** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 74** SL1yo, Knit all the remaining stitches, BOR, Cut B yarn.

**Round 75** Knit all, BOR.

**Round 76** SL1yo, Knit all the remaining stitches, BOR.

In Round 77, if you knit while changing to one size thin needle, the first step of the rib will be beautiful.

**Round 77** Knit all, BOR.

----

When the sleeve is knitted, it becomes 95 stitches.

## Cuff

Change to one size thin needle. Knit the ribs on the cuff with Single-rib stitches.

**Round 1** [ K, P, K2tog, P, K, P2tog ] \*11, K, P, K2tog, P, BOR.

When the finished round 1, it becomes 72 stitches.

**Round 2 to Round 10** Single-rib stitches all, BOR.

Bind-off the stitches with a technique to stretch. Cut yarn.

## Collar

Change to one size thin needle. **Start to the center in back.**

Pick up 136 stitches from the cast on in first neckline. Put the BOR Marker again.

This pattern reduces the number of stitches by 10%. If the neck is loose, increase the reduction rate or increase the rib rows.

**Round 1** [ K, P, K, P, K, P, K, P, K, P2tog ] \*13, K, P, K, P, K, P2tog, BOR.

When the finished round 1, it becomes 122 stitches.

**Round 2 to Round 10** Single-rib stitches all, BOR.

Bind-off the stitches with a technique to stretch. Cut yarn.

Fasten off, weave in ends, Finished!

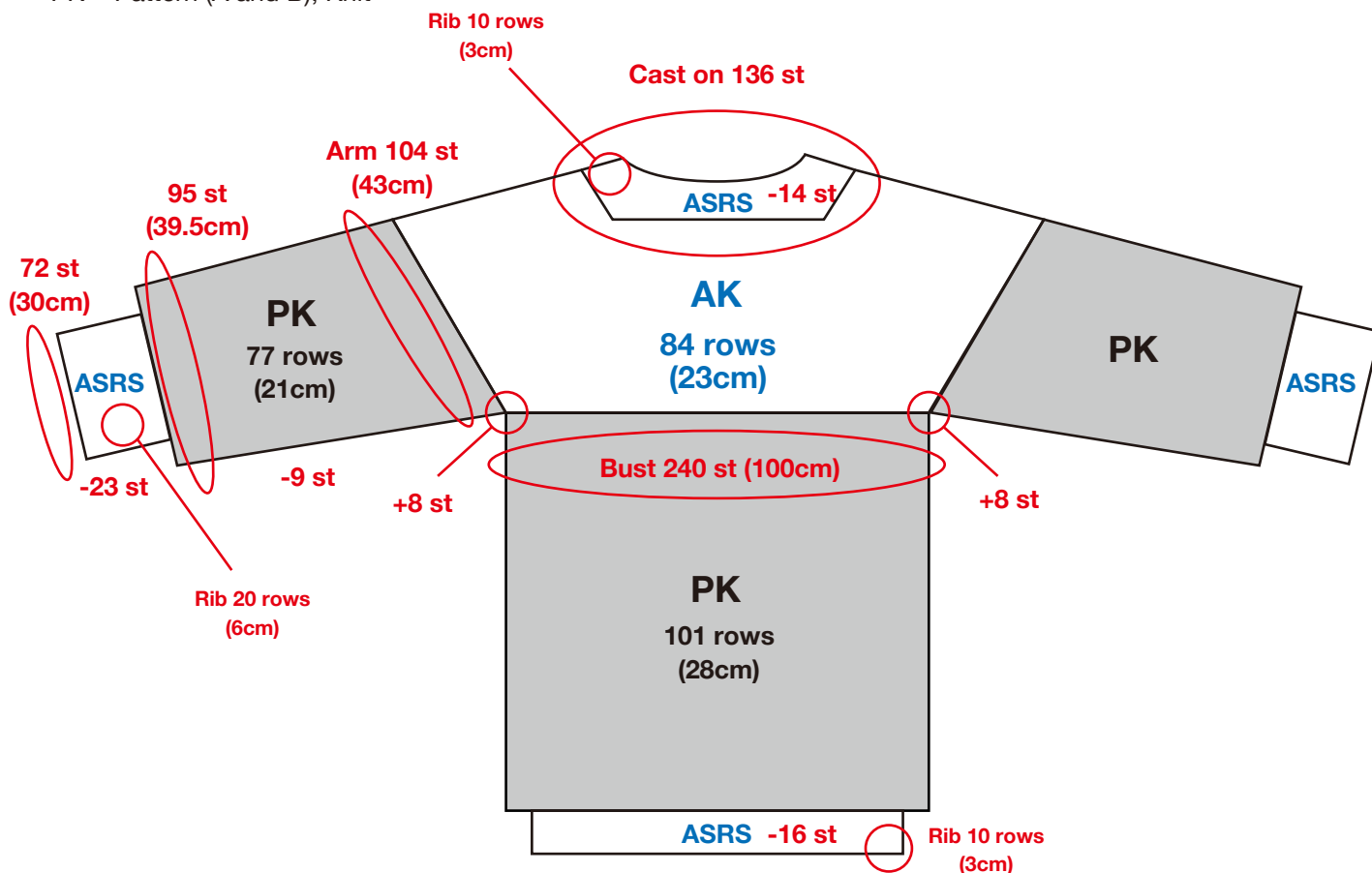

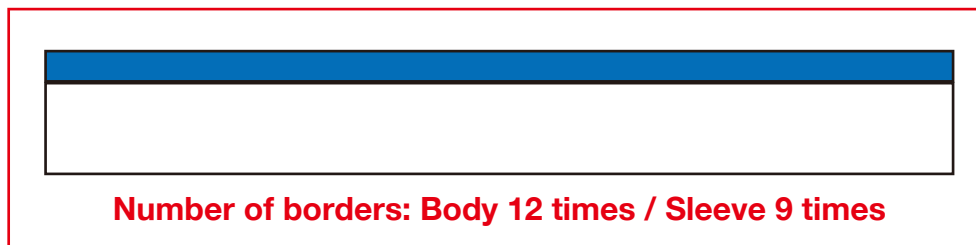
AK = Main yarn (A), Knit
